

Editorial rules

Articles that are accepted for publication but do not meet the editorial guidelines will be returned to the authors for revision based on these. In case of non-compliance, the respective article will not be published.

1.1 The article must be written in font 12, Times New Roman, spacing between lines 1.5, centered text (justify) and not exceed 30 pages (including those with illustrations).

1.2 Authors are requested to mention, at the beginning of the document, their full name, profession, institutional affiliation, an email address.

1.3. The article will be accompanied by a summary of 300-500 characters in one of the languages: English, French, German (in which the title will also be translated) and 5-7 keywords. If the article will be in a foreign language, the summary and keywords will be in Romanian, and the title will also be given in Romanian.

1.4. The bibliographic references will be found in the body of the text, between round brackets (...), as follows:

1.5. Footnotes are accepted for acknowledgments or other important remarks that need to be developed separately.

1.6 At the end of the article, a bibliographic list will be added, in alphabetical order (following the websites), and one of abbreviations (in alphabetical order; the establishment of the abbreviations used is at the discretion of the authors, but it is important that they be specified in the list of abbreviations).
